

We appreciate your help as we work around the challenges presented by the COVID-19 pandemic. In order to have a safe and successful season, please read and follow our COVID-19 precautionary protocols as summarized below. These protocols may be updated as the season progresses and we will inform you if such changes occur.

1. **Stay Away:** If you have a fever or any Covid-19 related symptoms do not attend the game. If you have been exposed to Covid, then you should quarantine for at least 10 days before attending.

2. **Limited Attendance:** We ask that a maximum of 2 family members attend the game. In addition, do not enter the gym before your scheduled practice or game time and exit promptly once your game is completed. We have allowed for extra time between practices and/or games so that there should only be one group inside the facility at any given time.

3. **Masks Requirements:** Everyone is required to wear a mask when entering and exiting the facility, including players. Coaches, parents, and other spectators are always required to wear a mask while inside the facility. During games, players and referees have the option of whether or not to wear a mask while on the court. While on the bench or not in the game, players are required to wear a mask.

4. **Hand Sanitizer and wipes:** There will be hand sanitizer and wipes on the table with the clock. Coaches should apply hand sanitizer to each player before the game starts. The clock and pens used should be wiped before each game.

5. **Social Distancing:** Everyone should attempt to social distancing while in the gym. This applies while sitting on benches or standing. Coaches should avoid a traditional huddle – players sitting together on the bench while the coach gives instructions. Instead players should all stand as the coach gives instructions. Standing allows everyone to spread out.

These protocols are modeled after those implemented by the Westlake High School, Hill Country Middle School, and Westridge Middle School basketball teams. Thank you for working with us to create a safe environment for our players and families--we hope to be back to normal procedures soon.
